

# 2018-2019 L.H.S. Student Dress Code

Students are expected to be in 100% full dress code while in the building. Below is an abbreviated version of the uniform policy. **See the 2018-2019 SJPPSS Student Policy Manual for full details of student dress code regulations.**

**LHS emblems are the only emblems allowed. Other visible emblems (ex: Nike, Adidas, LSU, etc) are NOT allowed on ANY article of clothing.**

## Shirt

- oxford or knit shirt with collar
- 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade **gold** collared polo-style uniform shirt **or gold uniform t-shirt (T-shirts can be purchased at <http://www.threestitchesembroidery.com/>)** These are the only two uniform shirt options for the middle school students.
- 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> **white** uniform shirt or school-issued LHS Bulldog t-shirts (NOTE: Beginning with the 2017-2018 school year, students in grade 9 through 12 have been allowed to either wear a white uniform shirt OR a school-issued Litcher High Bulldog t-shirt any day of the week as their uniform shirt. Students may not wear their PE shirt all day as their school uniform shirt. It can only be used for PE class.)
- must be long enough to remain tucked at all times
- undershirts (short and/or long sleeve) may be worn only if they are **solid** white, navy, black, grey
- no visible writing can be seen through the gold or white uniform shirts

## Bottoms

- khaki-colored uniform style pants or shorts (**no shorter than 3 inches above the knee**); Students are prohibited from wearing jean, denim, cargo pants/shorts, drawstring clothing, jogger pants and/or warm-ups.
- appropriate size for student (not too tight and not too baggy) (**discretion made by administrators**)
- worn at the natural waist (above hip bone)
- no side pockets or external pockets allowed
- pants hemmed appropriately (no frayed hems or "cut offs" allowed)
- no off-white, mustard, or "putty" colored pants or shorts are allowed

## Belt

- must be worn at all times
- may not be more than one size larger than the waist
- belt buckles shall not be larger than 2 inches by 1 inch

## Socks

- must be worn at all times
- white, khaki, black, navy, gray or school approved color
- tights or stockings may be worn in the same colors of white, navy blue, khaki/tan/brown
- may NOT have any inappropriate designs

## Shoes

- must be completely enclosed
- heels should be no more than 2 inches high
- slippers, flip flops, boots to the knee or other inappropriate footwear will not be allowed

## Miscellaneous

- Sweatshirts, jackets, and bundles of the high school t-shirts will be offered at the back-to-school prep day and in the front office.
- When approved by the principal, sports teams and clubs may request to wear special shirts/jerseys **ONLY** on days where there are scheduled activities, games or meetings.
- Coats/Jackets/Sweatshirts/Wind Breakers: Solid white, solid black, solid navy, gray or khaki; no stripes; only school approved monograms; no logos; no name brands. NOTE: School organizations' jackets and sweatshirts are allowed. **(Beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, no hoods are allowed on jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts, and coats.)**
- **The wearing of caps, hats, bandanas, wraps, curlers, and gloves inside the building is PROHIBITED.**
- Earrings should be worn in the ear lobes only and may be no larger than 1" in diameter and/or length. The wearing of body-piercing jewelry other than for pierced ears is prohibited (nose, lips, tongue, eyebrows, etc.).
- **Blankets are not allowed and are not considered part of the uniform.**
- Picture ID cards must be visibly work on school-approved lanyards at all times. Defacing ID's is prohibited.
