It is the goal and desire of the Administration of Lutcher High School to provide a quality experience for the students. In order for us to do that, the students need to read, understand and follow the rules and guidelines set forth.

- Students in the junior and senior cohorts enrolled at LHS are allowed to attend the prom provided they are in good discipline and academic standing.
 - Students with 2 or more suspensions and/or 5 or more discipline referrals from Categories A and B prior to the prom will not be allowed to attend.
 - Students who have attended the Alternative Center at any point during the school year will not be allowed to attend.
 - Students must have passed 2 or more credits first semester and be passing 3 or more credits second semester prior to the prom.
 - Students planning on attending the prom must be in good standing with their attendance.
 - Students who have any school debt are not allowed to attend.
- Out of school guests must be approved by the date established by administration.
 - Dates or escorts cannot be 21 years of age or older and must have an "out of school guest" form completed.
 - No student younger than 9th grade will be allowed to attend.
 - Students are subject to disciplinary action based upon the behavior of their guest.
- Students will not be allowed to leave and re-enter the prom.

Prom Sign Up: January 29 – February 2

All students must sign up if planning to attend and **MUST** be approved by administration before proceeding with the timeline events. Prom sign up will be online on the LHS webpage.

DO NOT purchase prom attire unless you are approved to attend.

Out-of-School Guest Forms

Forms will be available in the front office starting on **February 5**. They are due back no later than **March 8**.

Ticket Sales: March 4 – 21

Student and guest must be approved before purchasing tickets. Tickets are \$50 per person.

PROM DRESS CODE

All students must wear formal or semi-formal attire.

- Formal and semi-formal attire may include a dress suit, dress pants, and a sports coat or a tuxedo or this may include a formal or semi-formal dress.
- Students may not wear jeans.
- Dresses may be strapless (if they fit properly or include spaghetti straps)
- Dresses may be backless, as long as they are not cut below the naval.
- Two-piece dresses are allowed but the midriff of the top and the waist of the bottom cannot show more than three inches of skin.
- Dresses may not have a slit that exceeds mid-thigh.
- Dresses may not be cut below the bust line.
- Undergarments should not be visible.
- See-through apparel is not permitted.
- Garments that are tight or low cut are also unacceptable.

It is the responsibility of any LHS student bringing on out-of-school guest to make his/her guest aware of the school's prom dress code policy.

Any student wearing attire that does not fit within the acceptable parameters will not be allowed to board the bus and will not be able to attend prom. If you are unsure, ASK AN ADMINISTRATOR.

THINGS TO KNOW FOR PROM NIGHT

- Buses will leave at **6:30 PM** promptly.
- Students should be at the designated area for check-in and loading **by 6:00 PM**. Once checked in, students will board the bus. There will be no loitering outside the buses.
- All prom attendees must present a picture ID to board the bus. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- You must ride the same bus home that you rode to the Prom. **EVERY** student will ride home on the buses.
- Backpacks and large purses will not be allowed on the buses. Small clutches or purses will be allowed.
- Parents will not be allowed into the prom venue due to the fact we are paying for everyone that enters.

Anyone suspected of drug or alcohol use prior to boarding the buses will not be allowed to attend, and their parents will be notified. If any student is caught with drugs or alcohol at the prom facility, they will be isolated (subject to legal action) and the proper authorities and student's parent will be notified. Since this is a school function, all school rules and regulations will apply.
